

The Jewish Passover & First Pentecost - Jane Mithen

Approximately 1300 years before the first Pentecost, God miraculously delivered the ancient Israelites from Egyptian slavery through his servant Moses. This year, the Jewish people will be celebrating Shavuot or Passover, June 11-14, in remembrance of what God had done. Yet an even far greater miracle and redemptive plan would occur through Jesus Christ our Savior and Paschal Lamb. God the Father would send God his only Son, Jesus because of his love for the world, to save the world from sin (John 3:16). Fifty days after Christ's resurrection from the grave, and 10 days after his ascension, the promised Holy Spirit would be poured out on his disciples gathered together

in Jerusalem (Acts 2:1-4). At Pentecost, the old covenant would have a new covenant grafted to it. Where there was death, life would now occur, where there was the law there would now be the Spirit. The finger of God that had written down the Law on tablets of stone, would now miraculously be written on each believer's heart. Now all Christians would belong to a chosen race and a royal priesthood, a holy nation to proclaim the excellencies of Him who called them out of darkness into his marvelous light" (1 Peter 2:9).
